

## Putting PRINCE2® into Practise (master class)

This workshop is designed to show how the theory of PRINCE2 (2009 revision) can be applied to real life projects and adopted as a working method across the organisation. It will deal with the practical problems that many organisations have experienced when trying to implement the method and offers practical strategies on how these can be overcome. The workshop will be delivered by an experienced PRINCE2 consultant who has extensive experience of not only training the PRINCE2 method but also implementing it across different organisations.

### Course duration

2-days

### Who should attend?

Project sponsors, project managers, senior managers, programme and project office staff familiar with working in a PRINCE2 project environment or may already have either Foundation or Practitioner level certification.

### Pre-requisites

Familiarity with the PRINCE2 methodology is required.

### Course content

Typically will include:

- Why projects fail
- Key elements of PRINCE2 and project life cycle
- Setting up the organisation and getting roles and responsibilities right
- Overcoming resistance to the method
- The need to tailor the method and tailoring strategies
- PRINCE2 templates and their use
- The problems with quality, requirements and stakeholders
- Establishing the right level of Control
- Reporting – getting it right
- The role of the project office

### Course objectives

Delegates will be able to:

- Understand why projects can fail
- Appreciate the challenges of implementing PRINCE2 as a method and the human behaviours involved
- Define the roles and responsibilities and how the organisation will work
- Understand and apply suitable tailoring strategies to various size projects
- Tailor and complete the key PRINCE2 templates
- Structure quality expectations and requirements where there are conflicting stakeholders views
- Understand the primary controls needed by the project and how they can be implemented
- Design a reporting structure
- Understand the type and level of questions that need to be asked at stage boundaries
- Understand the need for continuous improvement in implementing the method
- Understand the role of the project office and its role in implementing and owning the method

### Course style

These courses are highly participative using exercises, case studies and practical work.
