



APMP Exam Preparation Workshop (1-day)

This 1-day event is specifically designed to prepare candidates for the APMP examination. The focus is to provide attendees with information, guidance, exam practice and revision sessions in preparation for the examination. It relies on candidates having already studied the syllabus for the examination including the Association for Project Management's (APM) Body of Knowledge. Typically, this workshop is run 2 to 4 weeks prior to the candidates sitting the APMP examination.

Course duration

1 day plus a minimum of 10 hours of pre-study.

Who should attend?

This workshop is targeted at candidates who are either planning to re-sit the APMP examination or for candidates that have attended APMP training more than 3 months prior and had not taken the APMP exam, but now are scheduled to sit the APMP exam in the coming weeks. Typical delegates will be Work-package lead / managers, Project Office / Coordinators, Project or Programme Office Managers, Project Managers and Senior Project Managers.

Course objectives

Delegates will be able to:

- Prepare for the APMP examination.
- Know how to approach and plan their self-study time between this workshop and the APMP exam.

Course content

- Review of APM Syllabus topics.
- Revision questions (in exam style) and advice and tips for taking the APMP exam.
- Guidance as to how to focus and plan own self-study time leading up to the APMP exam.

Pre-requisites

Delegates must have already studied the syllabus for the examination including the Association for Project Management's (APM) Body of Knowledge e.g. delegates should have attended one of Provek APMP courses previously. This 1-day workshop is not a substitute for training in the topics covered by the APMP syllabus. Provek also recommend that delegates undertake their free online Project Management Assessment (PMA5) in order to assess their readiness and suitability for the APMP exam. This assessment also identifies the delegate's existing knowledge and experience and recommends both the areas of strength and areas for development required (www.provek.co.uk – Project Management Assessment).
