

PRINCE2® e-Learning

This programme is designed to provide delegates with an in-depth understanding of the principles and terminology of PRINCE2 to act as an informed member of a project management team on a project using the PRINCE2 method. It is also designed to enable delegates attain the level of competence required to pass the PRINCE2 Foundation and Practitioner exams with a minimum of classroom contact time. This is achieved using self study via e-learning and remote tutor support. This approach provides delegates with a greater degree of flexibility in the way they study than that of a standard 5 day classroom based event. Following completion of the e-learning delegates will have the option of taking the Foundation and Practitioner exams at either a Provek scheduled event or at one of the APMG's public exam centres using a Provek issued exam voucher. Note that a pass in the Foundation is a pre-requisite to sitting the Practitioner exam. All delegates are issued with a PRINCE2 manual, e-learning package which includes sample questions and PRINCE2 manual references and access to our remote tutor support.

Please note that this programme allows delegates to complete Foundation level training only, Foundation and Practitioner level or Practitioner level only (where delegates already hold a Foundation certificate).

Course duration

Self-Study plus 1 hour examination
Recommended minimum of 60 hours self-study time required for both Foundation and Practitioner. 40 hours for Foundation only.

Pre-requisites

Some experience in a project environment is recommended.

Course style

Self study via e-learning and remote tutor support.

Exam venues

Both exams are held at either a Provek scheduled event or at one of the APMG's public exam centres. Provek will discuss suitable exam dates and venues with you at the time of booking.

- Demonstrate that they understand the reasons behind the processes, products, themes, roles of PRINCE2, and that they understand the principles underpinning these elements.
- Demonstrate their ability to tune PRINCE2 to different project circumstances.
- Take both the Foundation and Practitioner exams (as applicable) following comprehensive preparation.



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
