

PRINCE2® Foundation Certificate (Self-Study)

This self-study guide will enable delegates with some previous exposure to PRINCE2 (2009 revision) to attain the level of competence required to pass the Foundation Certificate examination. It is designed to provide delegates with an in-depth understanding of the principles and terminology of PRINCE2 to act as an informed member of a project management team on a project using the PRINCE2 method, within an environment supporting PRINCE2. All delegates are issued with a PRINCE2 manual and a Foundation pre-study workbook which includes sample questions and PRINCE2 manual references. A free re-sit of the Foundation exam will be available in the unlikely event of a failure.
